Prime Minister Narendra Modi has called on creators to participate in the 25 Challenges under the theme 'Create in India' which is being organised by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. During his Maan ki Baat address, he encouraged creators to visit the website wavesindia.org to participate in these challenges which features growing opportunities in creative sectors such as gaming, animation, and filmmaking, among others. Earlier, on the 22nd of August this year, Union Minister for Information and Broadcasting Ashwini Vaishnaw unveiled the Create in India Challenge—Season One—in New Delhi. These challenges will serve as a precursor to the upcoming World Audio Visual and Entertainment Summit (WAVES), aligning with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of Design in India, Design for the World. According to the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, the World Audio Visual and Entertainment Summit will be organised from 5th to 9th February next year to propel India's media and entertainment industry and boost the creator economy.



The Supreme Court is slated to hear the suo moto cognisance of the rape and murder of a junior doctor at RG Kar Medical College and Hospital in Kolkata today. A three-judge bench headed by Chief Justice DY Chandrachud will resume hearing the case. Last week, the Bench, also comprising Justices JB Pardiwala and Manoj Misra, decided to postpone the hearing scheduled for September 27 on the West Bengal government's request. Taking suo moto cognisance of the incident, the Supreme Court termed it horrific, which raises systemic issue of the safety of doctors across the country. The top court also ordered the formation of a National Task Force to suggest measures for the security of medical professionals across the country, observing that the safety of doctors is the "highest national concern."



Defence Minister Rajnath Singh yesterday said India would have given a larger bailout package to Pakistan than sought by Islamabad from the International Monetary Fund had the neighbouring nation maintained friendly relations with New Delhi. Addressing an election rally in the Gurez assembly segment of Bandipora district, Singh referred to the Prime Minister's Development Package for Jammu and Kashmir announced in 2014-15. Reiterating the promises made in the BJP's election manifesto, Singh said that as the Defence Minister, he assured that if BJP candidate wins in the elections, then more people from Gurez will be recruited in the Indian Army.



Dakshata training for health care workers was held in Phek at District hospital from 26th-28th September. The training was held to train health care workers to identify and handle common cause of maternal and neonatal deaths, follow essential standards and importance of quality care around the time of childbirth, ensuring clinical practices for routine care and management of problems during various stages of labour. The training also empowered service providers at the delivery points to perform all the evidence based practices for maternity care during labour, delivery and immediate post-partum period to reduce maternal and neonatal mortality. Facilitators of the training were Dr Pangertemsu from District Hospital and senior nurses.
