Prime Minister Narendra Modi today distributed more than 51 thousand appointment letters to newly appointed youths in various government departments and organizations. Speaking through video conferencing, PM said, efforts are underway to provide permanent government jobs to youths. Mr. Modi said that the new recruits have joined the government at a time when the country has resolved to become developed. He urged the new recruits to not only perform well but to strive for excellence. The Rozgar Mela was organized at 40 locations across the country today with new recruits joining the Central Government across various Ministries and Departments. He highlighted the availability of various courses for government employees on the iGOT Karmayogi platform and encouraged them to utilize it.

In Arunachal Pradesh, Union Minister of State for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, and Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Prof. S P Singh Baghel distributed appointment letters to newly recruited candidates during the Rozgar Mela held in Itanagar today. A total of 142 candidates were given appointment letters on the occasion. Addressing the gathering Mr. Baghel said that this Rozgar Mela is one of the most important initiatives of the central government and said candidates are selected solely on their merit and potential today.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi today inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of multiple projects related to the health sector worth around 12 thousand 850 crore rupees in New Delhi on the occasion of Dhanvantari Jayanti and 9th Ayurveda Day. Prime Minister also launched expansion of health coverage to all senior citizens aged 70 years and above as a major addition to Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana. This will help provide health coverage to all senior citizens regardless of their income. The Prime Minister also inaugurated facility and service extensions at various AIIMS including one at Guwahati in Assam.

Union Home Minister, Amit Shah today flagged off the 'Run for Unity' at Major Dhyan Chand National Stadium in New Delhi. The event was organized to mark the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel who was born on 31st of October 1875. Speaking on this occasion, the Home Minister said, Today, India stand strong before the World on the path of becoming the leader in every field, and its foundation was laid by Sardar Patel. Minister also said that Unity Run is not just a resolution for the unity of the country, now the Unity Run has also become a resolution for a Viksit Bharat. Mr. Shah said Sardar Patel played a pivotal role in unifying the diverse princely states to form a united country.

Governor of Arunachal Pradesh KT Parnaik, interacted with the troops at various border posts along the 'Line of Actual Control' in Tawang District today. He reviewed the wellbeing and preparedness of the troop during the tour. Governor said that the international border in Arunachal Pradesh is of immense strategic importance and is very sensitive for national security. He urged the troops to remain vigilant and uphold the distinguished traditions of the Indian Armed Forces in safeguarding these sensitive areas.

The 2nd review meeting of Arunachal Pradesh Airport Area Planning and Development Authority was chaired by Chief Secretary today. In the meeting discussions on various topics like options and models for developing the development Area around the airport at Hollongi on the pattern similar to Aerocity. Also discussed measures and policies to regulate the growth and control unplanned development in the area.

Biyarum Wahge Minister Health and Family Welfare, Govt of Arunachal Pradesh inaugurated the LMO Plant and eight bedded ICU at Zonal Hospital Aalo in the presence of Deputy Commissioner of West Siang District today. The long felt requirement of Zonal Hospital now can cater the necessity for the patients. This Oxygen Plant can fill forty Oxygen Cylinder at a time. The Intensive care Unit is equipped with modern facilities.

A new Endangered Orchid Species, *Gastrodia lohitis* was discovered in Arunachal Pradesh. A team of BSI lead by Dr. Krishna Chowlu has identified a new orchid species, *Gastrodia lohitis*, during an exploration in the Tezu region of Lohit District. This discovery underscores the need for habitat protection in Arunachal

Pradesh to preserve the unique ecosystem that supports rare species. Scientists urge conservation measures to prevent deforestation and ensure the survival of this rare orchid species.

As a part of state wide Tobacco Free Youth Campaign 2.0 a raid was conducted at Yingkiong town today and in compliance of section 6(b) of COTPA act 2003 which states that there is prohibition of sale of tobacco products within 100 yards of educational institution both private and public. Approximately 17(seventeen) kg of different types of tobacco products and gutkhas were seized and 19 shopkeepers were fined for violation under section 6(b) of COTPA act 2003. The seized tobacco products were destroyed by the town magistrate. The shopkeepers were warned against selling tobacco products within 100 yards of educational institution and the team will be frequently conducting such kinds of raids quarterly.
