Addressing the convocation ceremonies of the University of Health Sciences and AYUSH located at Nava Raipur, the President said that states like Chhattisgarh have inexhaustible reserves of herbs. President Murmu said that, along with documenting it, research based on it should be promoted.

Addressing the convocation ceremony of IIT Jodhpur yesterday, he said that India is a land of infinite opportunities and hope, and the whole world is eager to participate in its development stories. Speaking at the event, Union Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat said that India is gaining a new identity in the world. More than one thousand students were conferred degrees during the convocation. The Centre has issued an advisory to curb hoax bomb threats on social media platforms and directed social media intermediaries to promptly remove hoaxes, report threats, and cooperate with authorities. The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, in a statement, said that social media intermediaries must adhere to the IT Act, 2000, the IT Rules, 2021, and the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. It also added that, as part of due diligence obligations, it is the responsibility of concerned intermediaries, including social media intermediaries, to take necessary action under the IT Rules, 2021, without delay. The Ministry has reiterated that intermediaries are required to provide relevant information and assistance to authorized government agencies within 72 hours to aid in investigations or cyber security efforts.



External Affairs Minister Dr. S Jaishankar emphasized that stable government over the past eleven years has significantly enhanced the nation's global standing. He was speaking at an event about Globally Emerging Opportunities in Pune yesterday. He said that substantial infrastructure developments, including roads, railways, and metros, have attracted foreign investment. Highlighting achievements such as the Chandrayaan mission and Vaccine Diplomacy, Jaishankar said that the world's trust in India has grown, particularly in collaboration with BRICS, the Quad, and other global partnerships.
