President Droupadi Murmu reached Malawi today for the third and final leg of the three African nation visit. This will be the first ever visit by the President of India to Malawi. On the three day visit in Malawi, President is scheduled to hold bilateral and delegation level meetings and also to interact with Indian diaspora. The President will be holding bilateral meetings with the President of the Republic of Malawi Lazarus Chakwera and delegation level talks tomorrow. During the visit, President is also scheduled to visit places of historical and cultural significance in Malawi.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has stressed that cultural pillars like language, literature, art, and spirituality shape a nation's identity. He emphasized that while the country is moving forward on the path of development, it remains deeply rooted in self-respect, self-confidence, and self-pride. Speaking during the International Abhidhamma Divas programme in New Delhi today, the Prime Minister pointed towards the teaching of Lord Buddha. On this auspicious occasion of Abhidhamma Divas, the Prime Minister extended greetings to all, especially to the followers of Lord Buddha. He said, today marks the sacred festival of Sharad Purnima and the birth anniversary of Maharishi Valmiki Ji.

The Supreme Court today upheld the constitutional validity of Section 6A of the Citizenship Act related to the grant of Indian citizenship to immigrants in Assam by a majority verdict of 4:1. A five-judge Constitution bench headed by Chief Justice DY Chandrachud said the Assam Accord was a political solution to the problem of illegal migration. Justices Surya Kant, M M Sundresh and Manoj Misra in their majority verdict held that Parliament had the legislative competence to enact the provision. The section 6A was inserted in 1985 following the Assam Accord.

The Government has set up a Pavilion on Digital India Innovation Zone at India Mobile Congress 2024. Electronics and Information Technology Ministry said, the pavilion aims to provide a hands-on experience to the delegates on various Digital Public Infrastructures like DigiLocker, UMANG, Aadhaar, UPI, eSanjeevani, ONDC, and Digital India BHASHINI. This year's commemoration promises a vibrant mix of activities aimed at engaging the local communities and honouring the memory of the fallen heroe

Arunachal Pradesh has become home for snow leopards with 36 such animals found in the latest survey, state's Forest and Environment Minister Wangki Lowang said on Wednesday. The Minister said that the Department of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change, in collaboration with WWF-India, has completed the first-ever statewide snow leopard population assessment in Arunachal Pradesh. In India, the snow leopard is found in J&K and in the Union territories of Ladakh, Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh in the Western Himalayas besides Arunachal Pradesh and Sikkim in the Eastern Himalayas.

Principal, Don Bosco School Fr. Josua has stressed that the first and foremost enemy of humankind is "global warming" and every individual must contribute towards safeguarding the environment. Fr.
