The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved two rail projects with an estimated cost of 6,798 crore rupees to provide connectivity, facilitate ease of travel, and minimize logistics costs. The first project involves the doubling of 256 kilometre of railway line from Narkatiaganj to Raxaul, Sitamarhi, and Darbhanga and the Sitamarhi-Muzaffarpur section. This project will strengthen connectivity to Nepal, Northeast India, and border areas by facilitating the movement of passenger trains alongside goods trains. Briefing the media in New Delhi after the Cabinet meeting yesterday, Union Minister, Ashwini Vaishnaw highlighted the importance of project in Bihar. Mr. Vaishnaw also informed that the CCEA has given its nod to a new railway line for Amaravati, which is the new capital city of Andhra Pradesh.

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh yesterday said, India and China have been involved in talks at both diplomatic and military levels to resolve their differences in certain areas along the Line of Actual Control, LAC. In his address at the inaugural session of the Chanakya Defence Dialogue 2024 in New Delhi, the Defence Minister said, following the talks, a broad consensus has been achieved to restore the ground situation based on the principles of equal and mutual security. Mr. Singh said, India has a distinctive vision regarding development and security, which has made self-reliance in defence a prominent national goal.

Justice Sanjiv Khanna has been appointed as the next Chief Justice of India. Law Minister Arjun Ram Meghwal said in a tweet that President Droupadi Murmu, after consultation with CJI, DY Chandrachud has appointed Justice Khanna as CJI with effect from 11th November. Justice Khanna is currently the second seniormost judge of the Supreme Court. He will become the 51st Chief Justice of India. Justice Khanna is due to retire on 13th May 2025. Incumbent CJI DY Chandrachud, who took charge on 9th November 2022, will retire on 10th November this year.

The Office of the Principal Accountant General Nagaland, Kohima has launched the SMS and Web based IT Project for the benefit of State Government employees. This project encapsulates entitlement functions like Pension, GPF and GE. The Chakhesang Students' Union (CSU) has announced a temporary suspension of its ongoing agitation against the National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) for 15 days.
