17 meteorological observatories have been set up across Nagaland since 1989, ensuring a robust weather monitoring system. This was stated by Advisor for Information & Public Relations and Soil & Water Conservation, Imkong L. Imchen during a social night organised by the Department of Soil & Water Conservation at Chümoukedima yesterday. He said, this system played a pivotal role in disaster preparedness and risk reduction in a state. Commending the department's remarkable contribution to the state's development, Mr Imchen said the department continues to be a pillar of support for the state's environmental and agricultural sustainability, contributing immensely to the well-being of Nagaland and the broader region. The Advisor also welcomed the department's collaboration with the Brahmaputra Board, underscoring that such partnerships bridges development gaps and enhance conservation efforts. Chairman of the Brahmaputra Board under the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Dr. Ranbir Singh acknowledged the efforts of the Government of Nagaland in promoting conservation practices that align with National Water Policies. Commisioner of Police Dimapur has announced cash award of 50 thousand rupees for providing information leading to the arrest of two wanted individuals. The wanted individuals are SS. Kilonser of NSCN-K(Nikki) Khevini T Yepthomi, a 50 years old presently residing near Hindi College, Padumphukhuri Dimapur and ILhovi @ Kimeyeto SS, from Natha village in Zunheboto, an accomplice of Ms Khevini. The Police requested any individual or organisation to give information or assistance about these two wanted persons. The Commissioner of Police assured that the identity of the

informer or informers will not be disclosed at all cost. Dimapur Municipal Council (DMC) said, Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) are statutory entities endowed with both legislative and executive powers to govern local affairs. As such it is not mandatory to consult any particular organisation on such matters although suggestions are always encouraged and welcome, the DMC said. In a statement, DMC requested those with grievances to approach the office instead of going to the press just to create confusion and tarnish the image of the newly installed civic bodies. If there are any complaints about unfair/illegal activities, it should be brought to the notice of the DMC or the concerned ULB, it added. Stating that DMC is open to dialogue, the Council encouraged all members of the community to engage with the municipal so that issues are addressed in a constructive and collaborative manner. The DMC asserted that together, we aim to foster a more efficient and transparent governance that benefits all residents and establishments of Dimapur. The DMC also appealed to the citizens not to cast aspersions based on hearsay as utmost efforts are being taken to streamline the system after the long gap. Earlier the Dimapur Chamber of Commerce and Industries has voiced serious concerns over the prevailing taxation regime imposed by the Dimapur Municipal Council describing it as unjustified and detrimental to the business community.
