### **HEADLINES:-**

### PM:

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will launch, inaugurate, and lay foundation stones for multiple projects related to health sector worth around 12,850 crore rupees in New Delhi today on the occasion of Dhanvantari Jayanti and the 9th Ayurveda Day. The Prime Minister will launch the expansion of health coverage to all senior citizens aged 70 years and above as a major addition to the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana. He will inaugurate facility and service extensions at various AIIMS including Guwahati in Assam. The Prime Minister will also lay the foundation stone for 21 Critical Care Blocks in Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Manipur, Tamil Nadu, and Rajasthan under the Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM).

## **LETTERS:**

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will distribute more than 51 thousand appointment letters to newly appointed youth in various government departments and organizations via video conferencing during the Rozgar Mela today. The Rozgar Mela will be organized at 40 locations across the country. The Prime Minister will also address on the occasion. Union Minister of State for External Affairs and Textile, Pabitra Margherita will attend the Rozgar Mela at the State Convention Centre in Shillong. The Department of Posts, NE Circle, Shillong is the coordinator of the programme in Shillong. Rozgar Mela highlights the Prime Minister's commitment to prioritizing employment generation.

#### **BYPOLL:**

In Assam, scrutiny of nomination papers of candidates for the bypolls to five Assembly seats were held yesterday with the nominations of 24 candidates in four assembly constituencies were found to be valid, but the scrutiny of nominations of 14 candidates in Samaguri constituency, was put on hold due to some issues in the documents of two independent candidates. The scrutiny will be held again today. A total of 38 candidates had filed their nominations till the last date on the 25<sup>th</sup> of this month for the bypolls to Dholai, Sidli, Bongaigaon, Behali and Samaguri assembly constituencies as these seats fell vacant with the representatives winning the Lok Sabha elections. Meanwhile the nominations of six candidates who have filed their nominations for the bypoll to Gambegre Assembly seat in Meghalaya have been found to be valid during the scrutiny held at Tura yesterday.

The polling will take place on November 13, and votes will be counted on November 23. Tomorrow is the last date for withdrawal of nominations.

#### **CABINET:**

In Arunachal Pradesh, the state cabinet has taken several decisions during its meeting chaired by Chief Minister, Pema Khandu yesterday. The State cabinet has approved renaming the Naharlagun Railway Station to Itanagar Railway Station and recommended to Government of India for consideration. The state cabinet has approved the Framing of Transfer and Posting Policy for nurses of all cadres as well as the proposal for one-time relaxation of Recruitment Rule of ANM and absorption of existing contractual ANMs on seniority basis and one-time relaxation of Recruitment Rule of Nursing Officers and absorption of existing contractual Nursing officers on seniority basis. A proposal to set up the Administrative Reforms Commission was also approved to ensure efficient governance and address challenges. The Special Investigation Cell (Vigilance) will be changed to Anti-Corruption Bureau. Amendment of the Arunachal Pradesh Victim Compensation Scheme 2011 and formulation of the Arunachal Pradesh Victim Compensation Scheme 2024 was also approved. The cabinet also approved for amendment of the Arunachal Pradesh State Human Rights Commission Service Rules 2022.

#### **INFORMATION:**

Director General, Northeast Zone at the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, K. Satish Nambudiripad yesterday reviewed the publicity and media outreach activities of the Press Information Bureau and All India Radio in Gangtok. Earlier in the day, He met Annapurna Alley, Secretary for Department of Information & Public Relations, Government of Sikkim.
