Prime Minister Narendra Modi will embark on a six-day visit to Nigeria, Brazil and Guyana today. In the first leg of his three-nation visit, Prime Minister Modi will travel to Nigeria at the invitation of Nigerian President, Bola Ahmed Tinubu. This will be the first visit by a Prime Minister of India to Nigeria in 17 years. From Nigeria, Prime Minister Modi will travel to the Brazilian city of Rio De Janeiro on the 18th of this month to attend the G20 Summit hosted by President Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva. India is part of the G20 Troika along with Brazil and South Africa and has been actively contributing to the ongoing G20 Summit discussions.

National Press Day was observed across the nation today to commemorate the establishment of the Press Council of India on November 16, 1966. The Press Council of India is a statutory body which was established to ensure the freedom of the press and to maintain and improve the standards of journalism.
