Nation is observing Constitution Day today. Government has announced year-long celebrations beginning today to commemorate the 75th year of the adoption of the Constitution of India. This year marks the 75th anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution and the year-long celebrations across the country will continue till 26th of November, 2025. On 26th November, 1949 the Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution which came into effect on 26th January, 1950. On the occasion of Constitution Day, a grand event will be organised at the Central Hall of Samvidhan Sadan in Delhi where President Droupadi Murmu will address the members of both the Houses of Parliament.

The Union Cabinet has given its nod to the National Mission on Natural Farming with a total outlay of the 2,481 crore rupees. Briefing media after the Cabinet meeting in New Delhi yesterday , Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said the Mission aims to revive natural farming for chemical free and sustainable farming. The Mission will be implemented in 15 thousand clusters in Gram Panchayats. The Cabinet has also approved One Nation One Subscription, a new Central Sector Scheme for providing country-wide access to scholarly research articles and journal publication, through a simple, user friendly and fully digital process. Six thousand crore rupees have been allocated for One Nation One Subscription for three calendar years-2025, 2026, and 2027. The Cabinet also approved the continuation of its flagship initiative, the Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) with an enhanced scope of work and an allocated budget of 2 thousand 750 crore rupees for the period till March 31, 2028. The Cabinet also gave its approval for the PAN 2.0 Project of the Income Tax Department. The financial implications for the PAN 2.0 **Project** will be one thousand 435 crore rupees.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has underscored the importance of making co-operatives climate resilient, saying they should be connected to the circular economy. He added that co-operatives could help the countries of the Global South, in particular, to achieve growth. Inaugurating the ICA Global Cooperative Conference at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi yesterday, Mr Modi stressed the need for the immediate necessity to promote start-ups in cooperatives. On the occasion, Prime Minister Modi launched a commemorative stamp on the International Year of Cooperatives 2025.

Nagaland is set to conduct the PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan (NAS) 2024 on 4th of December. The survey will cover 1077 sample classes of 742 Government schools, Private Unaided and Central Government schools including involvement of 1187 Field Investigators, 742 Observers and 25132 students. The NAS initiative serve as a key indicator of the educational health in the state, particularly for grades 3, 6, and 9 and the results will contribute to determining the Performance Grading Index of the state. The duration of the survey will be 90 minutes each for class 3 and 6 and 120 minutes for class 9. Officials from the Directorate of School Education, SCERT, NBSE and Samagra Shiksha along with District Level Coordinators will visit the school on 3rd December to assess the school readiness preparations for the Survey. A training for the Field Investigators is also scheduled in the 16 districts on 2nd of December.
