Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan has said that Cabinet's approval of PM Vidyalaxmi with an outlay of 3,600 crore rupees will remove obstacles to higher education and enable the country's youth to pursue their dreams. In a social media post, Mr Pradhan highlighted that collateral-free and guarantor-free education loans under PM Vidyalaxmi will maximise access to higher education for meritorious students. He said that this scheme will ensure that financial constraints do not prevent students from pursuing education. He said that education loans under PM Vidyalaxmi will be facilitated to students securing admissions in the top 860 Higher Education Institutions of the country based on the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF). Minister of State for Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions Dr. Jitendra Singh yesterday launched the Nation-wide Digital Life Certificate Campaign, 3.0 in New Delhi. Speaking on the occasion, Dr Singh said that Digital Life Certificate, Jeevan Praman is the vision of Prime Minister Narendra Modi for Digital Empowerment of Pensioners. This year, 1900 DLC Camps will be held in 800 cities and towns in with more than 1100 nodal officers. 1.8 lakh Gramin Dak Sewaks will provide services at the India Post Payment Bank Camps to be held in 785 cities and towns. The Pension Disbursing Banks will conduct DLC Camps in 157 cities and towns. Alternative non-digital methods will remain available for those who are unable to access the digital platform. Pensioners can still submit their life certificates through traditional means, such as visiting pension offices or using post offices.

The Ministry of Women and Child Development is observing Adoption Awareness Month 2024 to encourage legal adoptions in the country. This year's theme for the month is 'Rehabilitation of Older Children through Foster Care and Foster Adoption.' The Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA) has planned a mega campaign along with other events to draw attention to adoption-related issues, with an emphasis on the adoption of children who are older, have special needs, or are currently in foster care. As part of the annual campaign, the Ministry is celebrating the occasion in Lucknow on the 21st of this month in Uttar Pradesh. CARA will also launch a special campaign for online events.

Nagaland Super League is in preparations for the official launch in December.
