The nation is today paying tributes to the security personnel and victims who lost their lives while defending the Parliament during a terrorist attack 23 years ago on 13th December 2001. President Droupadi Murmu and Prime Minister Narendra Modi today paid tribute to the brave hearts who sacrificed their lives defending Parliament during a terrorist attack on this day in 2001. In a social media post, the President remembered the courage and selfless service of the security personnel, stating that they continue to inspire the country. President Murmu also said that the nation remains deeply grateful to them and their families. The Prime Minister also shared that the sacrifice of the martyred will forever inspire the nation. Mr Modi said that the country remains eternally grateful for their courage and dedication.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said that Mahakumbh 2025 will be a Mahayagya of Unity and Equality which will guide the nation and it will be discussed all over the world. The Prime Minister said this while speaking at a public gathering in Sangam area of Prayagraj after formally inaugurating the Mahakumbh-2025. The Mahakumbh will start on 13th of January next year and will continue till 26th of February. On the occasion, Mr. Modi launched development projects worth around 6670 crores, which includes various rail and road projects to boost infrastructure and provide seamless connectivity in Prayagraj. The Prime Minister said that his government is working towards enrichment of the culture and heritage.
