Two bills related to One Nation, One Election are scheduled to be introduced in the Lok Sabha today. Union Law Minister Arjun Ram Meghwal will introduce The Constitution (129th Amendment) Bill and The Union Territories Laws (Amendment) Bill in the Lower House. Union Cabinet headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi had approved the constitutional amendment bill recently to roll out the concept of simultaneous Lok Sabha and state assembly polls. The high-level committee on one nation, one election led by former president Ram Nath Kovind had recommended holding simultaneous Lok Sabha and state assembly polls in the country.



Prime Minister Narendra Modi chaired the fourth National Conference of Chief Secretaries in New Delhi yesterday The three-day conference, which began on Friday, focused on the evolution and implementation of a common development agenda and a blueprint for cohesive action in partnership with the states. Prime Minister Modi said the meeting also focused on how to boost infrastructure and leverage technology for better governance.



Union Minister of Ports, Shipping, and Waterways, Sarbananda Sonowal, yesterday unveiled the cargo promotion scheme 'Jalvahak' for boosting cargo movement on three national waterways. Jalvahak is aimed at incentivising the movement of long-haul cargo via national waterways on the Ganga, Brahmaputra, and Barak rivers. The cargo promotion scheme provides a direct incentive to the cargo owners to transport their goods via inland waterways for a distance of more than 300 km. Mr Sonowal also flagged off 3 cargo ships with

two dumb barges from the GR Jetty in Kolkata. It marks the beginning of the fixed scheduled service of cargo vessels from Haldia for National Waterways 1 and 2. Speaking on the occasion, the minister said the government has made a concerted effort to realise the tremendous potential of India's rich network of inland waterways.
