NEC

Union Home Minister Amit Shah yesterday inaugurated the 72nd plenary session of the North Eastern Council (NEC) at Prajna Bhavan in Agartala. Addressing the session, Mr Shah said time has come for a change in approach of the police force with the end of insurgency in the northeast, in order to ensure that people get speedy justice. He said Prime Minister Narendra Modi has brought peace in the region by inking 20 peace accords in 10 years, leading to

the surrender of 9,000 armed militants. The two-day conference has brought together Governors, Chief Ministers, and senior officials from Northeastern states to discuss and prioritize developmental strategies for the region. Union Minister for Development of the North Eastern Region, Jyotiraditya Scindia and Union Minister of State, Dr. Sukanta Majumder were also in attendance.

NE

Union Home Minister Amit Shah has said Prime Minister Narendra Modi has brought the northeast to the focal point. Addressing the 72nd plenary of North Eastern Council in Agartala, he said that the last 10 years have been very important for the north east. The Union Government is inspiring investors to make investments in the region. Minister for Development of North Eastern Region, Jyotiraditya Scindia credited the drastic drop in extremism and violence in the north east to the stupendous role played by Home Minister Amit Shah. He noted that there has been 71 per cent drop in extremist activities and 60 per cent drop in the loss of human lives in the region.

ASSAM:

Union Minister of Ports, Shipping, and Waterways, Sarbananda Sonowal has said that six projects worth 763 crore rupees have been incorporated under the Sagarmala Programme for the development of inland water transport infrastructure on National Waterways in the northeastern region. The Sagarmala program is the flagship scheme to promote port-led development in the country by harnessing India's 7,500-kilometer-long coastline.
