Prime Minister said, his dedication and service to the nation will continue to inspire everyone.

MAAN KI BAAT:

Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that Constitution is the guiding light of the nation and stated that it is a matter of great honour that the Indian Constitution is completing 75 years on 26th January next year. Addressing the nation in his Mann Ki Baat programme on Akashvani yesterday, Mr Modi said the Constitution has stood the test of time in every sense of the term. The Prime Minister noted that on the occasion of Constitution Day this year, many activities have commenced that will continue throughout the year. In this edition of Mann Ki Baat, Mr Modi highlighted two big achievements of India in the field of health. He termed it heartening that this success has been achieved through everyone's participation. Mr Modi mentioned that in the tea gardens of Jorhat in Assam, malaria used to be a major cause of concern for people until four years ago. But when the tea garden dwellers united to eradicate it, they started getting success to a great extent.

AKASHVANI:

The Implementation of Direct Benefit Transfer via the Public Financial Management System has supported the Digital India Mission, Akashvani News said, adding that it also enabled real-time, transparent fund transfers for over One thousand 206 schemes in the ongoing financial year. The highlight of this year has been the social security reforms for the Government employees with the Unified Pension Scheme, which will be implemented from April Next year. It guarantees assured pensions and inflation-adjusted benefits for retired personnel.
