Prime Minister Narendra Modi today inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of various railway projects via video conferencing. In a key move to further boost connectivity in the region, the Prime Minister inaugurated the new Jammu Railway Division. Speaking on the occasion, the Prime Minister said the launch of rail infrastructure projects in Jammu-Kashmir, Telangana and Odisha will promote tourism and add to socio-economic development in these regions.

Speaking on the occasion, Om Birla said, Panchayati Raj institutions are working towards the development of villages and realize the vision of self-reliant India. He said women have made a huge contribution to the country's heritage and culture.

The Indian Council of Medical Research has confirmed the detection of two cases of Human Metapneumovirus (HMPV) in Karnataka, identified through routine surveillance for respiratory viral pathogens. The Ministry of Health in a release has stated that these cases were detected as part of ICMR's ongoing efforts to monitor and control respiratory illnesses across the country. The ICMR emphasized that despite the detection of these two cases, there has been no significant increase in Influenza-Like Illness or Severe Acute Respiratory Illness cases in the country. Meanwhile,

amidst the rising concerns several states including Delhi and Karnataka have issued advisories to prevent spread of the virus.

The Department of Fisheries, under the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, organized a Northeastern Region States Meet to review the implementation of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana at Guwahati today. Chaired by Union Minister, Rajiv Ranjan Singh, the event witnessed the presence of Minister of State, MoFAH&D, George Kurian and other key dignitaries from the Northeastern states. In a major boost to the fisheries sector in the Region, the Union Minister inaugurated and laid the foundation for 50 impactful projects with a total outlay of ₹50 crore, including a central share of ₹38.63 crore. These designed are to enhance the region's infrastructure, productivity, and employment opportunities.

Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein has assured to sanction the construction of 4.5 MW Hydropower Project on Yargyapchu River to meet the power requirements of the Mechukha township. Mein said this while gracing the hoisting of high mast national flag in Mechuka under Shi Yomi district today. Acting on a reliable intelligence regarding an interstate drug peddler, a police team, led by Inspector Krishnendu Dev conducted a prompt raid at the suspect's residence at G-Sector, Naharlagun yesterday. During the search, four pouches of cannabis weighing 56.8 grams were recovered from a black handbag carried by the accused. A subsequent search of his residence yielded 81 pouches of suspected cannabis and 250 empty plastic pouches, indicating preparation for further distribution. The police have hereby urged the public to report any suspicious activities to the nearest police station and join hands in eradicating the drug menace from the community.

The Itanagar Police have successfully apprehended a gang of serial offenders involved in multiple theft cases in the Itanagar Capital Region. The arrests have come after a month-long dedicated investigation police led by a team. In Capital Police stated that the communique, gang's criminal activities spanned several months. The police used a combination of technical surveillance and local intelligence to track the gang. Acting on a tip-off, two suspects were apprehended on January 3, 2025, near SBI Itanagar. A third suspect was later arrested at Harmutty Railway Station, based on confessions from the initial arrests.
