The Nation is celebrating the 76th Republic Day today. President Droupadi Murmu led the Nation in celebrating the Republic Day from Kartavya Path in New Delhi. Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited the National War Memorial and paid tributes to the fallen heroes. Indonesian President Prabowo Subianto, as the Chief Guest, arrived in a ceremonial buggy with President Murmu. The National Flag was unfurled followed by the national anthem with a 21-gun salute.

A 160-member marching contingent and 190-member band contingent from Indonesia also took part in the Parade. Further, to honour the contributions in nation and society building, 10,000 special guests from various walks of life were invited as Government's Special guests to witness the event.

The 76th Republic Day was also celebrated across Arunachal Pradesh today. The main function was held in Itanagar where the National Flag was unfurled by Governor Lt. Gen. K.T. Parnaik (Retd.).
