The Prime Minister highlighted that to be successful in politics, one must have dedication, commitment, be a good team player, and make themselves available for the people. Mr. Modi also underlined that he

believes good people should continuously enter politics, and they should do so with a mission, not just ambition.



President Droupadi Murmu today said the Indian diaspora represents the true picture of India to the global community. The President was addressing the valedictory function of the 18th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas Convention this afternoon at the Janata Maidan in Bhubaneswar. She also spoke on the vision of Viksit Bharat.

The President also conferred the Pravasi Bharatiya Samman to distinguished members of the Indian diaspora for their excellence in different fields.



The Nagaland Health Protection Society has clarified that services under the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY) and the Chief Minister Health Insurance Scheme (CMHIS) have not been suspended. In a public notice, the Society emphasized that the services are fully operational unless a specific hospital has independently decided to suspend them, which would be in violation of the signed Memorandum of Understanding. The Society also explained that a miscommunication from the Insurance Company had occurred but has now been corrected. It reassured all empanelled hospitals that services under both schemes remain active. Additionally, the Society urged all stakeholders, including hospitals, to avoid issuing hasty notices without first verifying with the relevant authorities, to prevent confusion among the public. Dimapur said it has resumed services for PM-JAY and CMHIS beneficiaries to avail cashless treatment.



The Nagaland Health Protection Society has said that a total of 53.64 Crore rupees for claims under PM-JAY and CMHIS (General) has been paid to various empanelled hospitals during financial year 2023-24, while 34.54 Crore rupees for claims under CMHIS (EP) was paid during the same period. It said, for the current fiscal year 2024-25, 38.92 Crore rupees for claims under PM-JAY and CMHIS (General) and 33.52 Crore rupees under CMHIS (EP) have already been disbursed within Nagaland. For treatment availed outside Nagaland, claims paid amounted to 3.99 Crore rupees under PM-JAY and 3.81 Crore rupees under CMHIS (EP) in FY 2023-24, and 1.95 Crore rupees under PM-JAY and 10.16 Crore rupees under CMHIS (EP) for FY 2024-25. The Society said, utilization of premiums was growing annually at a compounded rate of 17 percent.



Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh Yogi Adityanath launched the Kumbhvani channel of Akashvani dedicated to Mahakumbh 2025 in Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh today. The Chief Electoral Office of Nagaland today published the Final Electoral Rolls with reference to 1st January 2025 as qualifying date. According to the published data, total electors in the State stands at 13 lakhs 45 thousand 197. These include 6 lakhs 72 thousand 685 male, 6 lakhs 72 thousand 509 female, and three of the third gender. The electoral roll was prepared by the respective Electoral Registration Officer of all districts in the State.
