The Government of India has officially inducted five Nagaland Civil Service (NCS) officers into the prestigious Indian Administrative Service (IAS). The appointments, made through the Select List of 2023, were notified by the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions (Department of Personnel & Training) yesterday. The officers inducted into the IAS are: Zarenthung Ezung; Zhothisa Dawhuo; Limawabang Jamir; Angelina Tajen and Akunu S. Meyase. The appointments were made under Rule 8(1) of the Indian Administrative Service (Recruitment) Rules, 1954, and Regulation 9(1) of the Indian Administrative Service (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955. These officers will serve on probation and have been allocated to the Nagaland cadre under Rule 5(1) of the IAS (Cadre) Rules, 1954. The vacancies filled by the Select List of 2023 were determined for the period between January 1 to consultation December 31, 2023, in with the State Government.

Replying to another query, the spokesperson said they have seen the announcement pertaining to the establishment of two new counties in Hotan Prefecture of China. Parts of jurisdiction of these so-called counties fall in India's Union Territory of Ladakh.
