The Northeast region needs more super speciality hospitals, Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare JP Nadda said yesterday. The Union Minister visited the Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health, the Mangaldai District Civil Hospital, and AIIMS Guwahati, to inaugurate new healthcare facilities and review ongoing healthcare projects. The need is to introduce more super speciality departments to better serve the Northeast and the nation as a whole, Mr Nadda said. At Mangaldai District Civil Hospital, the minister laid the foundation stone for a state-of-the-art 50-bed Critical Care Block, and inspected ongoing treatments at a cancer hospital.
