There has been significant drop in Road accidents in Dimapur, Chumoukedima, and Niuland over the last three years. This was stated by the Commissionerate of Police Dimapur. A Yearly Comparative Road Accident Data Report for 2022, 2023 and 2024 released by the Police highlights a steady decline in the road related vehicular accidents each year. The report reveals a 52.06 percent reduction from 557 accidents in 2022 to 267 in 2023. The following year, 2024, saw an even steeper drop of 58.8 percent with the number of accidents falling to just 110. Comparing 2022 to 2024, the data shows a total reduction of 447 accidents, reflecting an impressive 80.25 percent decrease over the three-year span. The Police said this drastic reduction in accidents can be attributed to a variety of factors, including improved traffic regulations, enhanced road safety campaigns, better infrastructure, and public awareness efforts aimed at reducing road fatalities and injuries.

In line with the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation's directives, the Department of Economic & Statistics has constituted two key committees to oversee the implementation of the 8th Economic Census in Nagaland. The State Level Coordination Committee (SLCC) and District Level Coordination Committee (DLCC) have been formed to monitor the preparedness, progress, and resolve any issues related to the execution of the census across the state. According to the official notification, the SLCC will be headed by the Chief Secretary of Nagaland as the Chairperson. The committee also includes several senior

officials from various departments such as Industries & Commerce, Rural Development, Information Technology & Communication, Labour & Employment, and Economics & Statistics, among others. The Director of Economics & Statistics will serve as the Member Secretary. The DLCC will be chaired by the Deputy Commissioner of each district.
