Speaking at the grand opening of the first season of the NSL at the Chümoukedima Football Stadium yesterday, Mr. Rio thanked the people of the state and all participants for coming together to make the NSL a reality, adding that the event marks the creation of history for the state. He expressed hope that the league would bring glory to the people, the state, and individuals alike.

In a significant step towards prison reform and inmate rehabilitation, the M/S Ummeed Prison Welfare Service Station was officially inaugurated at the District Jail, Dimapur yesterday. This first-of-its-kind petrol pump, operated by trained inmates under the supervision of prison staff, is a collaboration between the Prison Department of Nagaland and the Indian Oil Corporation Limited as parts of its corporate social responsibility program. Unveiling the inaugural plaque, Advisor for Prisons and Printing & Stationery, Kropol Vitsu commended the innovative project, emphasising, that this service station is not just a business venture but a symbol of hope, skill development, and empowering inmates to reintegrate into society.

Nagaland DGP, Rupin Sharma reflecting on the project's journey, explained that it was born out with a desire to establish self-sustaining, reform-driven programs within the prison system.

Operational since December 23, 2024, the station, equipped with 8 nozzles and a fuel capacity of 12,000 liters, has already served over 17,900 liters of fuel. Managed by nine trained inmates, it aims to generate revenue for prison welfare activities and provide fair wages to the inmates for their contributions.
