# RESCUE

As rescue operations continue to dewater the flooded rat-hole coal mine in Umrangso's Tin Kilo, Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma has ordered a judicial inquiry into the incident to be headed by retired judge of Gauhati High Court Anima Hazarika. The inquiry is expected to examine the matter and "fix responsibility against responsible officers, individuals and institutions." The decision was taken during a cabinet meeting in Morigaon yesterday with Chief Minister Sarma informing that the enquiry committee is expected to submit its report within three months. In addition to the judicial probe, a Special Investigation Team will also be formed to investigate the incident based on FIRs filed in connection with the incident.

### **MIZORAM GOVERNOR**

Former Army Chief General (Retd), Vijay Kumar Singh was sworn-in as the 25th Governor of Mizoram yesterday. General Singh was administered the oath of office by the Chief Justice of Gauhati High Court, Justice Vijay Bishnoi at the Circular Lawn, Raj Bhawan in Aizawl. Chief Minister Lalduhoma and two previous Chief Ministers — Lal Thanhawla and Zoramthanga also attended the swearing-in ceremony. Singh was born on May 10, 1951. An Alumnus of Birla Public School, Pilani and National Defence Academy, he served as the 26th Chief of Army Staff of the Indian Army. General Singh had successfully contested the Lok Sabha election from Ghaziabad Parliamentary Constituency in 2014. He was inducted as Union

Minister of State and assigned various portfolios such as External Affairs, DoNER and Overseas Indian Affairs.

#### **UNNATI**

Manipur Chief Minister, N. Biren Singh said that the North Eastern Region is set to become the growth engine of new India under the leadership of Prime Minister, Narendra Modi. Speaking at the inaugural function of State Level Workshop on UNNATI and RAMP Scheme at Imphal yesterday, Singh said that Manipur topped the list of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises business registration among the North Eastern states according to the Annual Report 2018-19 of the Ministry of MSME. He also said that Manipur alone has over twelfth thousand four hundred MSME businesses being the highest in the North East during the period from 2015-2019. The Chief Minister said that fifty percent of the businesses are owned by women and Manipur's share in national population is only 0.2 percent while the State share in MSME businesses is 0.3 percent. During the technical session of the workshop, resource persons delivered lectures on both the schemes which was attended by government officials, entrepreneurs, and representatives from business establishments.
