Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said, Assam is now the centre of unlimited possibilities and gateway to South East Asia and India. The Prime Minister said this while addressing the inaugural session of the Advantage Assam 2.0 Investment and Infrastructure Summit in Guwahati today. Speaking before a large gathering of diplomats, prominent industrialists, foreign delegates, the Prime Minister said that Assam will be a manufacturing hub of Eastern India and urged the industrialists to reap the benefits of this strategic location.

The Prime Minister informed that his government is working on improvement of connectivity, infrastructure and also strengthening the local supply chains in this region. India is working on a mission mode for low cost manufacturing process. The PM said that the law and order situation of Assam has improved during the last few years as the Centre and State government have signed several peace accords.

The Election Commission of India has scheduled a two day conference with the Chief Electoral Officers of all States/UTs at the India International Institute of Democracy and Election Management, New Delhi from March 4th to 5th next. This is the first

such conference to be held since Gyanesh Kumar assumed charge as Chief Election Commissioner, informed a press statement.

Range Forest Officer trainees from the Chandrapur Forest Academy of Administration, Development, and Management, Maharashtra, visited Pakke Tiger Reserve, Seijosa yesterday. The visit, a part of their 18-month training course, is an essential part of their East India tour, aimed at providing practical exposure to forest and wildlife management. The field trip was mostly focused on the Center for Bear Rehabilitation & Conservation and the Khari Anti-Poaching Camp, where they observed conservation efforts, habitat management strategies, and wildlife protection measures in action. The visit to Pakke Tiger Reserve provided the trainees with a holistic understanding of wildlife conservation, habitat restoration, and community involvement in forest management. This hands-on experience will be instrumental in shaping their future roles as forest officers, stated a press statement.

The Banderdewa Police have successfully intercepted a drug trafficking attempt and seized 150.70 grams of heroin at the Banderdewa check gate yesterday. Acting on a reliable intelligence input, a police team led by ASI S.K. Tiwari conducted a naka check at Banderdewa check gate. A search of two suspects, conducted in the presence of OC, PS, Banderdewa resulted in the recovery of heroin from their possession. In the meantime, a case has been registered at Banderdewa Police Station under the NDPS Act. Further investigation is underway to track down the supplier and dismantle the supply chain, stated a press statement.

The District Health Society, Tawang, in collaboration with the Indian Army, successfully organized an Integrated Mega Health Camp at Government Higher Secondary School, Lhou today. The camp provided free medical services such as Non-Communicable Disease Screening, Dental Check-ups, Electrocardiography and Tuberculosis screening. The camp was jointly inaugurated by Deputy Commissioner, Tawang, Kanki Darang and Zila Parishad Chairperson, Tawang, Leki Gombu. This initiative reflects the strong civil-military partnership in ensuring accessible healthcare for the rural population of Tawang, further strengthening community well-being and cooperation.

A one day free legal awareness camp was organized by the District Legal Services Authority, East Siang in collaboration with Legal Aid Cell, Faculty of Law and Forensic Sciences, Apex Professional University, Pasighat yesterday. The programs were specially initiated for the Gaon Burah/Buris of Bilat Block, East Siang District. More than 70 participants were present in the program including GB's of Bilat Block, resource-persons, Advocates and others.

The India Meteorological Department has issued a Yellow Alert for eighteen districts of Arunachal Pradesh for the next 24 hours. IMD has predicted rainfall with thunderstorms and lightning at isolated locations. Isolated snowfall is also forecasted at higher altitudes of Tawang District.
