Prime Minister Narendra Modi received a warm welcome upon his arrival in France. Upon landing, he was greeted at the airport by France's Minister of the Armed Forces, Sebastien Lecornu, while the Indian community in Paris gathered to offer their heartfelt greetings.

Later, the Prime Minister took to social media and mentioned that he had received a memorable welcome in Paris. He expressed gratitude toward the diaspora and conveyed his pride in their accomplishments.

MLA and Chairman Zunheboto District Planning and Development Board, DPDB Picto Shohe has asked all Head of Departments to continue to serve the district with sincerity. Addressing the DPDB board meeting in Zunheboto yesterday, Mr. Shohe requested the board members to be watchful in development aspects towards Atoizu. He highlighted that Atoizu is till date without bus services despite being one of the earliest subdivisions in the state. Mr. Shohe further appealed to the concerned departments for improvement of roadways in the area keeping in mind Khelhoshe Politechnic at Asukuto town.

The Union Home Ministry has informed that the seizure of drugs worth over 25 thousand crore rupees in 2024 is part of its ongoing Zero Tolerance policy against drugs. In a statement, the Ministry noted that this represents a 55 per cent increase compared to the more than 16 thousand crore rupees worth of drugs seized in 2023. The Ministry also highlighted the rise in the seizure of more harmful and addictive substances, including synthetic drugs, cocaine, and pharmaceutical drugs used as psychotropic substances. Notably, the quantity of cocaine seized increased significantly, from 292 kilograms in 2023 to one thousand 426 kilograms in 2024, while the seizure of hashish rose from 34 quintals in 2023 to 61 quintals in 2024.

Union Health and Family Welfare Minister JP Nadda asserted that the government is committed to eliminating Lymphatic Filariasis, LF from the country by 2027, while seeking active community involvement to achieve the goal. Mr Nadda was speaking after the launch of the Annual Nationwide Mass Drug Administration campaign for LF elimination through a video conference.

Dimapur District BJP President Shekishe Achumi said that BJP's recent victory in the elections, both at the national level and the Delhi Legislative Assembly, is a monumental event for the party across the country.
