NORTH EAST

Union Home Minister Amit Shah yesterday said that the entire North East is now on the path of development and the policies of the Narendra Modi government have transformed Tripura from a landlocked state to a land-linked state. Shah was addressing the distribution program of over 2,800 appointment letters in Tripura through video conference. The Home Minister highlighted that in the last 10 years, the Narendra Modi government has made three agreements in Tripura to bring peace to the state. He said that armed groups in Tripura have been eliminated, surrendered and joined the mainstream. He also said that the Modi government has brought a positive change in the lives of the Bru-Reang people by providing them with permanent residency, education, healthcare, and job opportunities. Shah stated that Tripura has moved ahead on the path of participation instead of distraction, speed instead of obstruction, and welfare instead of delay.

SCINDIA

Union Minister for Communications and Development of North Eastern Region, Jyotiraditya Scindia, has said that the North Eastern States have become a priority for the Government, as for the first time in 65 years, infrastructure facilities such as rail, road, and air services have been modernized and increased over the past ten years. Delivering his speech after the inauguration of the roadshow in Chennai yesterday, the Minister pointed out that in the next decade, the North Eastern States will undergo a transformative journey, thereby providing a fast-growing ecosystem to the whole world. The Minister said the Central Government has envisioned several projects to enhance economic opportunities in the region.

APPROVE

The Centre has approved the National Glacial Lake Outburst Flood Risk Mitigation Project, aimed at reducing the devastating impact of glacial lake outburst floods which will be implemented in four states, Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Himachal Pradesh, and Uttarakhand. The total financial outlay is 150 crore rupees. Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Nityanand Rai, in a written reply told the Lok Sabha that Arunachal Pradesh has been allocated 45 crore rupees with the Centre contributing 40.50 crore rupees from the National Disaster Mitigation Fund, while the state government will bear the remaining 4.50 crore rupees.

IMD

India Meteorological Department has forecast light to moderate rainfall accompanied by thunderstorms and lightning over Arunachal Pradesh and northeast Assam untill tomorrow, and heavy rainfall over Arunachal Pradesh tomorrow. IMD said that another fresh Western Disturbance is likely to affect the Western Himalayan Region from Saturday. Under its influence, light rainfall and snowfall activity is likely over the Western Himalayan Region from the 8th to the 11th of this month.

GREEN

PM Shri Government Senior Secondary School, Namchi in Sikkim is the only educational institution to receive a Green School Rating from the entire North Eastern states. Green Carnival and Green School Award Ceremony 2025 was organized by the Centre for Science and Environment, CSE, in New Delhi. Green Carnival and Green Award Ceremony is the annual event organized by the CSE to engage young environmentalists from various schools across the country. Awards are presented to schools which are rated 'green' after evaluating and analyzing the Green School Audit reports spanning from July-December. According to the report of CSE, there were more than 10,000 schools which submitted Green School Audit reports, out of which only 150 schools were rated Green School for the session 2024-25 from across the country.
