The Election Commission commenced the first-ever training programme for over one lakh Booth Level Officers (BLOs) in New Delhi today. Chief Election Commissioner Gyanesh Kumar, along with Election Commissioner Dr. Vivek Joshi, inaugurated a training programme held at India International Institute of Democracy & Election Management in the National Capital. Over one hundred BLOs from Bihar, West Bengal and Assam are participating in the two-day residential training programme along with 24 Electoral Registration Officers and 13 District Election Officers from Bihar, West Bengal, Assam, Kerala, Puducherry and Tamil Nadu. Talking to the media, CEC Gyanesh Kumar said that India's election is the biggest in the world, and to conduct this election, the Election Commission makes 10 lakh fifty thousand booths. He further informed that over one lakh BLOs will be trained in the training programmes.
