Strengthening educational and sports infrastructure in Arunachal Pradesh, Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein inaugurated the newly constructed School Auditorium and Football Stadium for Independent Golden Jubilee Govt Higher Secondary School in Pasighat yesterday. These state-of-the-art facilities, developed under the IGJGHS School Heritage Redevelopment initiative by the Pasighat Smart City Development Corporation Ltd, reaffirm the government's commitment to foster holistic development for the students. Later, Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein attended the UnyingA:ran Spring Carnival at the Gi:diNotko Festival Ground in Pasighat as Chief Guest. In his address, DCM commended this year's UnyingA:ran Festival theme of 'No Hunting'. He said that UnyingA:ran was known as a hunting festival so far, however, now the Adi community have realized the bad effects of rampant hunting and have come together to celebrate the festival with a motto to spread the message of 'No Hunting'.

Minister for Education & Tourism, P. D. Sona has lauded the vision of organizing the festival of Unying Aran Spring Festival with a message of conservation of flora and Fauna. The Minister while attending the festival at Pasighat yesterday added that the innovative idea of maintaining tradition during Aran and at the same protecting wildlife by symbolic customary gifting by the organisers is truly a praiseworthy conservation effort. Sona additionally stressed on documentation of rich cultural and folk traditions. Lok Sabha MP Tapir Gao who was also in attendance at the festival, gave a clarion call for protection of biodiversity and wildlife to save from extinction. Gao further urged for eschewing wildlife hunting as our precious wildlife are on the verge of extinction.

The ambitious 10-day journey features a team of 10 dedicated personnel: 2 officers, 1 Subordinate officer, and 7 other ranks. Throughout the expedition, the ITBP team will engage with local communities and school children, fostering a strong connection with the region's inhabitants. Additionally, they will share the glorious history of the ITBPF, demonstrating their vital role in safeguarding the nation, and provide hands-on demonstrations of mountaineering skills and infantry weapons. The team will also distribute sports equipment to encourage physical activity among the youth, conduct career counseling sessions to guide students towards promising futures, and raise awareness about the importance of wildlife conservation in the region.

DMO and Vice Chairman of the Papum Pare District Health Society, Dr. Rina Ronya has stated that every child in Papum Pare has been vaccinated at least once. Dr. Rina said this while the Papum Pare District Health Society launched the Special Vaccination Campaign (SVC) 3.0 at Tigdo III yesterday. Speaking on the occasion, she thanked the DRCHO, Anganwadi workers, Asha workers, and sisters for successfully implementing SVC 3.0. The campaign aims to scale up Td10 and Td16 coverage, achieve 95% MR1 and MR2 coverage, and vaccinate all eligible children for Pentavalent-1 between six weeks and one year of age. Additionally, the campaign seeks to eliminate zero-dose children.

In solidarity with institutions across the country and globally, the Department of Social Work, Rajiv Gandhi University celebrated World Social Work Day 2025 today. The programme aimed to recognise the invaluable contributions of social workers and promote intergenerational solidarity as a key to fostering enduring well-being.
