The Rajya Sabha has passed the Protection of Interests in Aircraft Objects Bill, 2025. The bill seeks to give legal effect to the convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment. The Bill also empowers the central government to make rules to implement the provisions of the Convention and the Protocol. The legislation designates the Directorate General of Civil Aviation as the registry authority for the purposes of the convention. The registry authority is responsible for the registration and de-registration of aircraft.

The initiative, led by the Department of Fisheries, West Kameng district, and supported by the National Fisheries Development Board, Hyderabad, aims to enhance fish stock, maintain biodiversity, and discourage harmful fishing practices.
