The India Meteorological Department has said that the Southwest Monsoon seasonal rainfall from June to September this year is likely to be above normal. The India Meteorological Department has issued Yellow alerts over West Kameng, East Kameng, Kra Daadi, Lower Subansiri, Papumpare, Dibang Valley, Anjaw, Lohit, Changlang, Tirap and Longding districts of Arunachal Pradesh. IMD has forecast rainfall with thunderstorms with lightning very likely to occur at isolated locations over the next 24 hours.

The Upper Subansiri District Unit of the All Arunachal Pradesh ASHA and the Felicitators Workers Union, held a peaceful dharna at Daporijo today.
