Union Home Minister Amit Shah has said that the three new criminal laws are the biggest reforms of the 21st century, and the government is trying to make the justice system people-centric and scientific. Addressing the All India Forensic Science Summit in New Delhi yesterday , Mr Shah said the government is working to ensure that those seeking justice get timely justice and also the satisfaction of getting justice.

The Centre has framed draft rules for Gas Meters under the Legal Metrology (General) Rules, 2011. Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution in a statement said that these rules make it mandatory for all gas meters used for domestic, commercial, and industrial purposes, to undergo testing, verification and stamping prior to their use in trade and commerce. The reverification of these gas meters is also prescribed under the rules to ensure their correctness when these are in use. The Ministry added that the primary objective of these new rules is to ensure accuracy, transparency, and reliability in the measurement of gas. The Ministry said that following deliberations, the rules were finalized with a provision for a transitional period to allow industry implementing authorities for and to prepare compliance.

Fugitive diamond trader Mehul Choksi has been arrested by the police in Belgium. A report claimed he was arrested on Saturday at the request of the Central Bureau of Investigation and is currently in jail. Choksi is wanted in connection with the Punjab National Bank loan fraud case. Reacting to Mehul Choksi's arrest, Minister of State for Finance Pankaj Chaudhary said, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had already said that the ones who have looted the money of the poor will have to return it.
