Government is sending seven multi-party delegations to different countries to present India's stand against Pakistan sponsored terrorism in the wake of Operation Sindoor. The delegations are set to visit key partner countries, including members of the UN Security Council later this month. These delegations will carry forth India's strong message of zero tolerance against terrorism to the world. The seven delegations will be led by BJP's Ravi Shankar Prasad and Baijayant Panda, Congress's Shashi Tharoor, JDU's Sanjay Kumar Jha, DMK's Kanimozhi Karunanidhi, NCP's Supriya Sule and Shiv Sena's Shrikant Eknath Shinde. Highlighting its significance, Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju said that the seven all-party delegations will carry India's shared message of zero-tolerance to terrorism, standing as a powerful reflection of national unity above politics beyond differences.

Haryana Police has arrested Jyoti Rani, a YouTuber from Hisar, on charges of spying for Pakistan. A case has been registered against Jyoti at Civil Lines police station in Hisar. She has been produced in the court and taken on five-day remand. Hisar Dy SP Kamaljeet said that Jyoti was in contact with Pakistan's intelligence agencies and was sending intelligence information through social media. He said that Jyoti has traveled to Pakistan four times, due to which India's security agencies were keeping an eye on her. Haryana Police also arrested a youth, Devender Singh aged 25, from Mastgarh village in Kaithal, on charges of spying for Pakistan's intelligence agency ISI. Kaithal SP Aastha Modi said that Devendra had sent confidential information related to the Indian Army including Operation 'Sindoor' to Pakistan.

A patriotic Tiranga Yatra was held at Doimukh today, organized by Citizens to express solidarity with the Indian Armed Forces and commend Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership. The yatra, which commenced at the Welcome Gate and concluded at CHC Doimukh, drew a large crowd of local residents, including Gaon Burhas and Gaon Burihs. Ex-MLA Tana Hali Tara addressed the gathering, praising the Indian Army's actions against terrorism, particularly in response to the Pahalgam terror attack.

India Meteorological Department has issued red alert for two districts in Arunachal Pradesh. IMD has predicted thunderstorm with lightning and heavy to Very Heavy Rain in the next 24 hours at isolated places in Upper Siang and West Siang districts. IMD also issued orange alert with heavy to Very Heavy Rain in Lower Dibang Valley, East Siang, Papum Pare and West Kameng districts.

Arunachal Pradesh Literary Society (APLS) has decided to confer the Luminous Lummer Dai Literary Award 2025 to Ramchandra Chutia and Dr. Ashok Kumar Pandey. The Luminous Lummer Dai Literary Award 2025 will be conferred on Chutia and Dr. Pandey on 1st June at Lummer Dai Bhawan, Tezpur, Assam, on the occasion of 85th Birth Anniversary of Lummer Dai, the Doyen of Arunachal Literature. Instituted by the APLS in 2016, so far 11 writers have been honoured with this prestigious literary award.

In a major bureaucratic reshuffle, Itanagar Capital Region Deputy Commissioner Talo Potom and Superintendent of Police Rohit Rajbir Singh, and the Anti-Corruption Bureau's Special Investigation Cell SP Anant Mittal have been transferred to New Delhi.

India will face Bangladesh in the final of the ongoing SAFF U-19 Championship at Golden Jubilee Stadium, Yupia on Sunday evening. India entered the final after beating Maldives 3-0 in the second semifinal on Friday. Danny Meitei opened the scoring for India in the 14th minute, before local boy Omang Dodum doubled the lead in the 21st minute. The last goal was scored by Prashant Jajo in the 65th minute. On the other hand, defending champion Bangladesh secured their spot in the final, beating Nepal 2-1 in the first semifinal earlier on the day.

Star Indian javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra finished second at the 2025 Doha Diamond League Men's Javelin Throw event on Friday. Despite a record-breaking 90.23 meter throw, Neeraj had to settle behind Germany's Julian Weber who startled everyone with a final throw of 91.06 meters.

In the meantime, Prime Minister Narendra Modi has congratulated Olympian Neeraj Chopra for surpassing the 90-meter mark at the Doha Diamond League 2025.
