Deputy Chief Minister TR Zeliang has reaffirmed the importance of Nagaland's traditional governance system. India achieved a significant milestone with the launch of 101st mission of its space programme. ISRO's PSLV-C61 rocket lifted off with Earth Observation Satellite, EOS-09 at 5:59 AM today from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre at Sriharikota in Andhra Pradesh. However, the mission could not be accomplished. Up to the second stage, the performance was normal, but some issues were encountered in the third stage. The mission was aimed at placing the EOS-09 into a Sun Synchronous Polar Orbit. The EOS-09 is designed to provide continuous and reliable remote sensing data for operational applications across

various sectors. The mission carried a Synthetic Aperture Radar payload capable of providing images for various earth observation application under all-weather condition. The spacecraft was to be a debris-free mission.
