The government has approved a semiconductor unit to be set up near Jewar airport in Uttar Pradesh. Briefing media in New Delhi yesterday, Information and Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said, the unit is to be set up under the India Semiconductor Mission with the joint venture of HCL and Foxconn. He said, the plant is designed for 20 thousand wafers per month and the design output capacity is 36 million units per month.

The Minister said, five semiconductor units are already in advanced stages of construction and with this sixth unit, India moves forward in its journey to develop the strategically vital semiconductor industry. Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that the Cabinet decision regarding the establishment of a semiconductor unit in Uttar Pradesh will boost growth and innovation. In a social media post, Mr Modi said, it will create innumerable opportunities for the youth as well. He said, India's strides in the world of semiconductors continue.
