Prime Minister Narendra Modi will participate in the G-7 Summit at Kananaskis, Canada later tonight. Mr Modi reached Calgary this morning on a two-day visit to Canada. He will be participating in G-7 discussions on the future of energy security, technology, infrastructure and investment, to ensure access and affordability in a changing world. This would be PM Modi's 6th consecutive participation in the G-7 Summit. Prime Minister will exchange views with leaders of G-7 countries, other invited outreach countries and Heads of International Organisations on crucial global issues.

As a run-up to International Yoga Day 2025 on the 21st of this month, Morarji Desai National Institute of Yoga today organised the Yoga Bandhan programme in New Delhi. The programme witnessed the participation of prominent delegates from various countries, including Denmark, Indonesia, Malaysia, South Korea, Argentina, among others.

Over the last decade, India's healthcare system has undergone a remarkable transformation. Flagship initiatives like Ayushman Bharat have provided financial protection to nearly 55 crore people. While under the Ayushman Vay Vandana scheme, the health assurance benefits have been extended to all senior citizens aged 70 and above. The Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission has modernised healthcare delivery, with over 78 crore Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts (ABHAs) created, enabling seamless access to personal health records.

The North Eastern Council (NEC) has released over Rs. 11 crore for multiple development projects in Arunachal Pradesh, covering key sectors like tourism, agriculture, technology, and others. A major highlight of the initiative is the pioneering project titled "Technological Intervention using Artificial Intelligence and Internet of Things for Smart Agriculture in North East India," led by the NERIST in Nirjuli.

This three-year initiative, scheduled to complete by April 2028, will introduce a smart farming system using technology to monitor soil moisture, temperature, humidity, and crop health in real time.

Four of the five National People's Party (NPP) MLAs in Arunachal Pradesh have joined the People's Party of Arunachal (PPA). It was confirmed through an official communique issued by the Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly Secretariat on Monday. The MLAs who have shifted to the PPA are Namgey Tsering, Pesi Jilen, Tapi Darang, and Oni Panyang.

The two-day Annual Conference of Relief Commissioners and State Disaster Response Force of States and UTs-2025 concluded in New Delhi today. Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister, Dr. P. K. Mishra chaired the valedictory session. Speaking on the occasion, Dr. P K Mishra said, the annual conference is a shared opportunity to reflect, recalibrate, and reinforce collective approach to disaster risk management.

The Meteorological Centre Itanagar has issued an orange alert for 4 districts in Arunachal Pradesh. The districts are Papum Pare, Pakke Kessang, Lower Dibang Valley and Lohit. These places are very likely to receive thunderstorms with lightning and very heavy rainfall in isolated places over the next 24 hours. The Meteorological Centre has also issued a yellow alert for 16 districts. Arunachal Pradesh is likely to receive heavy rainfall at certain places in the next few days.

Arunachal Pradesh has bagged 13 medals at the 4th KIO National Sub-Junior, Cadets & Junior Karate Championship 2025 held in Uttarakhand. The medal tally includes 2 Gold, 6 Silver and 5 Bronze. Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein has congratulated the players and Arunachal Pradesh Amateur Karate Do Association for the noteworthy performance in the championship.

State Disaster Response force in collaboration with the East Siang District Police held a Mock exercise cum earthquake preparedness drill at Gandhi Chowk in Pasighat today. On the occasion, Pasighat Fire and Emergency Services Department gave a fire demonstration and also taught do's and don'ts to locals at the time of fire emergency.

The Department of Horticulture successfully organized a Buyer-Seller meet at the ADC Office Conference Hall in Sagalee in Papum Pare District today. The initiative under the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana aimed at connecting buyers and sellers, promote local

horticulture produce, and foster trade partnerships for sustainable growth. Over 200 farmers from the Sagalee division attended the event.
