Prime Minister Narendra Modi has concluded his historic and first-ever official visit to Croatia. Packed with high-level engagements, the visit marked a significant elevation in India-Croatia ties and set the stage for future strategic collaborations. Prime Minister held wideranging delegation-level talks with his Croatian counterpart, Andrej Plenković, at Banski Dvori during his day-long visit to the central and southeast European country. Both leaders issued a joint press statement, emphasising their commitment to global peace. PM Modi strongly advocated peaceful resolution of conflicts, stating that whether in Europe or Asia, solutions cannot be found on the battlefield. He said dialogue and diplomacy are the only viable paths forward.

The government is making all out effort to ensure the safe return of Indian nationals from Iran and another flight carrying members of the Indian mission is expected to arrive today. Earlier, 110 Indian students evacuated from northern Iran, arrived in New Delhi. Talking to media in New Delhi, Minister of State for External Affairs Kirti Vardhan Singh said that the government has received over 350 requests of Indian citizens in Iran for evacuation.

Union Home Minister Amit Shah today said that the time has come to reclaim India's linguistic heritage and lead the world with pride in native languages. Speaking at a book launch in New Delhi, Shah said that the languages of the country are the jewels of its culture. He said that foreign languages cannot capture the essence of Indian culture and history.

Government is working towards bringing about a transformative change in the lives of tribal communities across the country. In an exclusive interview with the Akashvani News, Minister of Tribal Affairs Jual Oram said that his ministry has implemented various schemes and programmes in the last 11 years to ensure that tribal communities are not left behind.

State Assembly Speaker Tesam Pongte called on Governor Lt General (Retd) KT Parnaik at Raj Bhavan today. They discussed the evolving role of the State Legislature and its contributions to the State's development and governance. The Governor commended the Speaker for the integration of Artificial Intelligence tools and the transition to a fully paperless system, describing it as a transformative step that positions the Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly among the most forward-looking in the country.
