Directorate General of Civil Aviation has directed Air India to carry out additional safety inspections on Boeing 787-8/9 aircrafts equipped with Genx engines as a preventive measure following the Aircraft crash in Ahmedabad, Gujarat. The DGCA said the inspection should be carried out with immediate effect in coordination with its concerned regional offices.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited the Ahmedabad Civil Hospital in Gujarat this morning and met the lone injured survivor Vishwash Kumar Ramesh, a British national of Indian origin of Air India plane crash. Modi also visited the plane crash site and took stock of the situation. His visit came a day after Air India's Boeing 787-8 crash, which claimed 241 lives including former Gujarat CM Vijay Rupani and 12 crew members onboard.

Chief Minister Pema Khandu expressed his heartfelt condolences on the tragic Air India flight accident that occurred in Ahmedabad, Gujarat yesterday. In his message, the Chief Minister extended condolences to the bereaved families on behalf of the people of Arunachal Pradesh. The State Government also joined the nation in mourning this loss and offered prayers for all those affected.

Governor KT Parnaik concluded his visits to four Military Stations in Assam, by laying a wreath at 4 Corps War Memorial in Tezpur today. In the meeting, Mein proposed for grand celebrations at Pangsau Pass Winter Festival as part of the 80th commemoration of World War II, to conduct a Willy Jeep Rally from the Hump WWII Museum in Pasighat to Pangsau Pass and a Super Car Rally to draw attention from tourists and history enthusiasts.
