Prime Minister Narendra Modi yesterday hosted members of the seven all-party delegations which recently visited various countries as part of India's diplomatic outreach to convey its strong stand against Pakistan-sponsored terrorism after Operation Sindoor. Dr. Jaishankar, who is currently visiting Europe, stated this in an interview with an American political digital newspaper. UNDERPLAY- Pavan means wind and mukta means to release or to make free. This asana is useful in removing wind or flatulence from the stomach and intestines. It removes constipation, decreases the bloating sensation in the abdomen and aids digestion. The asana offers deep internal pressure, massage and stretching of the muscles, ligaments and tendons in the pelvis and waist region. It also tones up the back muscles and spinal nerves.



Kohima Police personnel from Sechü (Zubza) Police Station have arrested four habitual offenders linked to a string of theft cases spanning the past three years. The arrests were made yesterday following a complaint filed by a resident of Sechü (Zubza). The accused, aged between 20 and 28, have been identified as Throngso Khiung Yim, Thoungaolou, Khriesietuo Dzuvichü, and Ruokuozhao Semou. According to police, the group had been systematically stealing scrap materials, automobile parts, engine components, batteries, and other valuables from a business establishment located at the old KMC dumping site since 2023. The stolen items are estimated to be worth around 4 lakh rupees. The suspects are also allegedly involved in the theft of iron materials belonging to the National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL), intended for the ongoing four-lane highway project at Zubza. A case has been registered, and further investigation is underway, police said.
