Prime Minister Narendra Modi today highlighted the transformative role played by women in the journey towards a developed India, underlining the government's focus on women-led development over the past 11 years. The Phevima (Kacharigaon) village council has resolved that it will not comply with the 30 percent wage component demanded by the Rural Development department under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) for the financial year 2024-25. Council Chairman Vitho Zao informed that the decision was taken during a general meeting of the village. He added that a resolution was submitted to the department. Mr. Zao said, daily wage of 234 rupees per person under MGNREGA is now directly credited to beneficiary bank accounts, out of which the department has instructed the village council to collect 30 percent and return it to the department. The council also alleged that the department has been asking for 50 percent deduction from the material component. The council has urged the government to stop taking villagers' money and asked other villages to join their resistance.

The Nagaland Pradesh Congress Committee (NPCC) has expressed outrage and concern over alleged unauthorized and illegal deductions from Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) funds from beneficiaries across Nagaland by Rural Development Department. A press statement from the NPCC said that these funds represent the lifeblood of rural aspirations, not only driving critical grassroots-level infrastructure development but also serving as a vital instrument to provide social security to the most marginalized communities. Accusing the Rural Development Department of abusing its of power, it called on the Minister of RD Department and the state government to take immediate and decisive action to put an end to this rampant corruption The NPCC also urged the concern authrities to ensure that those involved are identified and penalized in accordance with the law of the land.
