The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), Dimapur District, organized a Press Conference-cum-Exhibition and Professional Meet in Dimapur today, as part of the nationwide campaign commemorating 11 years of the BJP-led Union Government. Themed “Viksit Bharat Ka Amrit Kaal” and “Seva, Garib Kalyan Ke 11 Saal,” the event highlighted the achievements and transformational policies of the central government since 2014. The press conference was addressed by State BJP President Benjamin Yephthomi, PHED Minister Jacob Zhimomi and Advisor for Tribal Affairs and Election, Tovihoto Ayemi. Addressing the conference, Jacob Zhimomi termed the occasion as one of the most significant events in the BJP's political calendar, reflecting on the sweeping changes brought about under Prime Minister Modi's leadership.

Tovihoto Ayemi said summarizing the last 11 years in a single sitting is a challenge. Highlighting the transformation, he said with the adoption of advanced technologies and citizen-centric governance, India is now progressing alongside the rest of the world.

Addressing the media, State BJP President Benjamin Yepthomi informed that Nagaland has recorded over 2.6 lakh primary memberships and around 5,000 active members.



The Nagaland Police has named 31 individuals, including six government officials, in a criminal case related to the illegal encroachment of land at Dimapur Airport. A press release from the Nagaland Police stated that the case follows an enquiry ordered by the State Home Department into allegations that portions of airport land had been encroached upon using forged and fabricated documents. Investigation from a Special Investigating Team (SIT), found sufficient grounds to recommend chargesheeting 31 accused persons comprising 25 private individuals and six public servants- under various sections of the Indian Penal Code, including criminal conspiracy, cheating, forgery, and other related offences. In this regard, the SIT has filed chargesheets against the 25 private individuals in the appropriate court in Dimapur. While, for the six government officials, the Investigation Officer has submitted a prayer to the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms and the Department of Land Records for prosecution sanction, as mandated under law for public servants.



AYUSH Minister Pratap Rao Jadhav today said that Yoga represents India's aspiration for global well-being. Speaking at the Global Yoga Summit – Yoga Connect in New Delhi, he said that Humanity is presently facing various challenges across the world and added that Yoga is a gift and legacy from India to the world for global peace.

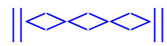
