Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Jammu and Kashmir today and will lay the foundation stone, inaugurate and dedicate to the nation multiple development projects worth over 46 thousand crore rupees at Katra. As part of it, Prime Minister Modi will dedicate Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Rail Link (USBRL) project to the nation. The 272-kilometre USBRL project has been constructed at a cost of around 44 thousand crore rupees. The USBRL project is a fully electrified section and comprises 36 tunnels and 943 bridges. The Chenab Bridge, the world's highest railway arch bridge and India's first cable-stayed rail bridge - Anji Khad Bridge, which are part of the USBRL, will also be inaugurated by the Prime Minister. The Prime Minister will also flag off two Vande Bharat Express trains - one from Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra to Srinagar and other from Srinagar to Katra. However, the regular services of Vande Bharat trains between Katra and Srinagar will commence from Saturday.

Efforts include heritage development—restoring Sikh gurdwaras, Buddhist viharas, Jain temples, Sufi dargahs, and tribal sacred sites. India has also successfully repatriated over 350 idols and artefacts from abroad. Pilgrimage connectivity has been enhanced under the PM Gati Shakti and Bharatmala initiatives, with better roads, ropeways, and rail links improving access to holy sites. This cultural renaissance is about preserving history, strengthening faith, and fostering unity for generations to come.).

The Kohima Police have issued a public notice warning against unauthorized modifications to vehicles, stating that any deviation from manufacturer specifications is a violation of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988. The notice highlights specific prohibited modifications, including altered exhaust systems in two-wheelers, non-standard or excessively bright LED lights, unauthorized sirens or blinkers, and tinted films that reduce visibility on vehicle windows and windshields.
