Prime Minister Narendra Modi today lauded the citizen-led 'Green Roing' initiative in Lower Dibang Valley district. Addressing the nation in his Mann Ki Baat program, PM Modi highlighted Roing as an inspiring example of how small towns are finding innovative solutions to cleanliness and environmental challenges. Mr. Modi informed that under the Green Roing Initiative, an entire park has been created from recycled waste. In the meantime, Chief Minister Pema Khandu has expressed pride over the recognition made by the Prime Minister. In a social media post, Mr. Khandu said, "It is always heartening when quiet, local efforts catch the attention of the nation. Green Roing isn't just a campaign. It's a movement."

The discussion on Operation Sindoor is expected to begin in Lok Sabha tomorrow.
