India and Namibia today signed an MoU in the presence of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, on the setting up of Entrepreneurship Development Center in Namibia. Both countries also signed an MoU on Cooperation in the field of Health and Medicine. Letters of acceptance for Namibia's joining of CDRI and Global Biofuels Alliance were presented. The MoUs were signed after the delegation-level talks between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Namibian President Netumbo Nandi-Ndaitwah at the State House in the Namibian capital, Windhoek. The deliberations were aimed to deepen the economic partnership between the two countries by exploring new areas of cooperation in critical sectors.

Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan has said that India must create a smart strategy that puts together academic knowledge with social good while meeting the aspirations and energy needs of society. Addressing the National Workshop on "Future Ready Energy Education: Opportunities and Challenges" organized by the Indian Institute of Technology Delhi in New Delhi, Mr. Pradhan said India is marching towards achieving the net-zero commitment by 2070. The Minister added that India is the third-largest energy consumer in the world, with only one-third per-capita energy consumption.
