External Affairs Minister Dr S Jaishankar today called on Chinese President Xi Jinping along with fellow Shanghai Cooperation Organisation members in Beijing. In a social media post, Dr Jaishankar said he briefed the Chinese President on the recent developments of the bilateral ties between India and China. He also conveyed the greetings of President Droupadi Murmu and Prime Minister Narendra Modi during the meeting.

Indian astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla and three other crew members of Axiom-4 mission safely returned to Earth after their 18-day historic mission aboard the International Space Station. The SpaceX Dragon spacecraft splashed down in the Pacific Ocean off the coast of San Diego in California this afternoon. Prime Minister Narendra Modi has lauded the safe return of astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla. Mr. Modi said, he joins the nation in welcoming Group Captain Shubhanshu Shukla as he returns to earth from his historic mission to Space.

Governor Lt. General KT Parnaik (Retd.), and Chief Minister Pema Khandu jointly launched the book 'Mystic Arunachal – Tales from India's Hidden Frontier' at the Chief Minister Conference Hall, Itanagar today. The book has been authored by Major Rahul Jha, Sena Medal, who is currently serving as the ADC to Governor. The book is a curated collection of fictional narratives, deeply inspired by the lived realities, oral traditions, and vibrant cultures of the indigenous communities of Arunachal Pradesh.

In response to the ongoing indefinite blockade called by the Mising community organizations, the Arunachal Pradesh Police today held a press briefing to provide an update on the investigations.
