Prime Minister Modi distributed over 51 thousand appointment letters to newly appointed youth in various government departments through video conferencing at the Rozgar Mela today. The Prime Minister speaking at the Rozgar Mela said the Rozgar Mela reflects the government's commitment to empowering the youth and making them catalysts in building a Viksit Bharat. He added that young individuals are now playing a major role in nation-building and the world acknowledges today that India possesses two boundless strengths- demography and democracy. The 16th Rozgar Mela was held at 47 locations across the country.

The Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) last night released its 15-page preliminary report of the investigation into the fatal Air India plane crash that claimed 260 lives in Ahmedabad on the 12th of last month. AAIB in its report said, within seconds of lift off, both engine fuel control switches of the aircraft transitioned from 'RUN' to 'CUTOFF' position one after another with a time gap of 1 second and turned off, resulting in devastating air tragedy.

The General Officer Commanding (GOC) of the 2 Mountain Division, Major General VS Deshpande, called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt. General KT Parnaik at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar yesterday. They discussed key issues concerning the international

border, the progress of the Vibrant Village Programme, and the Indian Army's ongoing Sadbhavana initiatives aimed at improving the quality of life for the local communities. In a social media post CM Khandu shared that focus areas included promoting kiwi as the state's USP, developing integrated tourism circuits, and branding Arunachal as the Orchid Capital of India. Steps to preserve Mon Shugu, the traditional Monpa handmade paper art, were also reviewed.

Kurung Kumey District Administration handed over Land Mutation Certificates with 690 hectares for the Frontier Highway Project to PWD and BRO. The stretches include Lada-Sarli, Sarli-Huri, and Huri-Taliha. During a state-level review meeting, the team's efforts were appreciated. A mutation certificate is a

document that reflects the transfer of property ownership in official land records.

Tingong Wangpan from Arunachal Pradesh has won Gold in the Men's 400m race in the T35 category yesterday, at the 7th Indian Para Athletics International Championship 2025 being held at Bengaluru.

Arunachal is planning to host Continental Rafting Championship in April 2026.
