Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone, inaugurated, and dedicated to the nation multiple development projects worth over 5,000 crore rupees at Durgapur in West Bengal this afternoon. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister said that these projects will significantly enhance the region's connectivity, boost gas-based transport, and support the gas-based economy. He said the identity of this steel city will be further strengthened through these initiatives. He also noted that West Bengal is one of the states in the country where Vande Bharat trains are operating in significant numbers.

Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla has stressed that Indian youth need the right guidance, technical support, and policy-making in their journey towards the goal of Viksit Bharat by 2047. In this regard, the Speaker emphasized the role of social organizations in the holistic development of society and the nation as extremely important. Additionally, creation of 10 posts under the Directorate of Civil Aviation has also been approved.

The meeting deliberated on the upcoming and ongoing examinations conducted by the Commission. The India Meteorological Department has issued a yellow alert for Lower Subansiri, Papum Pare, West Siang, Lower Siang, Lower Dibang Valley, Dibang Valley, Anjaw, Namsai and Changlang district in Arunachal Pradesh. IMD has predicted thunderstorms with lightning and heavy rain very likely at isolated places.
