The Union Cabinet has approved the employment-linked incentive scheme to generate employment and provide social security across all sectors, with special focus on the manufacturing sector. Briefing media about the Cabinet decisions in New Delhi today, Information and Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw informed that the Union Cabinet has also cleared the Research Development and Innovation Scheme with a corpus of one lakh crore rupees. Mr. Vaishnaw added that the National Sports Policy 2025 has also been approved to transform the country's sporting landscape and empower citizens with sporting activities. During the briefing, Mr. Vaishnaw stated that the Union Cabinet has also given its nod for the construction of a four-lane Paramakudi-Ramanathapuram section in Tamil Nadu with a cost of one thousand 853 crore rupees.

India is celebrating 10 years of the Digital India programme. Launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2015, the initiative aimed to use technology to improve governance and make everyday life easier for all citizens.
