REGIONAL ENGLISH NEWS BULLETIN

Member of Parliament Tapir Gao chaired the 1st Quarter District Development Coordination and Monitoring Committee (DISHA) Meeting for 2025 today and reviewed the progress of central schemes, and stressed on inclusive, transparent implementation across districts. Ministers, MLAs, DCs, HoDs, NHIDCL, SBI representatives and Zila Parishad Chairpersons from 11 districts were also present.

In a significant decision aimed at uplifting the dignity and welfare of its frontline workers, the Itanagar Municipal Corporation (IMC), under the leadership of Mayor Tamme Phassang, has unanimously resolved to enhance the salaries of its 204-ground staff. The resolution was passed during a special session held yesterday. Mayor Phassang emphasized the crucial role played by ground workers in maintaining cleanliness and hygiene of the city and called them the real backbone of IMC. Mayor further informed that entire IMC team, including officials and corporators, has decided to push for the enhancement of ground staff salaries, bringing them on par with other employees of similar grade in different government departments.

The Arunachal Pradesh Confederation of Medical Laboratory Science (APCMLS) today organised a blood donation camp at RKM Hospital, Itanagar. The camp was held as part of the ongoing National Medical Laboratory Professional Week-2025. Ngilang Tari, President of APCMLS, informed that the organisation represents medical laboratory professionals, technicians, assistants, technical supervisors, and officers. He also mentioned that several other activities are being conducted as part of the week-long observance.

Deputy Director School Education (DDSE) Yupia is organising a mandatory Aadhaar biometric update and new Aadhaar enrolment camps at all Higher and Secondary schools across Papum Pare from 15th July to 31st July 2025. The camp aims at facilitating Aadhaar Enrolment for ST students to ensure Aadhaar enrolment of eligible students for availing the centrally sponsored Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme and DBT-based government schemes for the students. Currently Education department Papum Pare has five Aadhaar supervisors, one each for the five educational blocks.

Arunachal Pradesh Pencak Silat team ranked 2nd runner up by securing 16 medals, including 5 Gold, 3 Silver, and 8 Bronze in the recently concluded two-day 7th Northeast Pencak Silat Championship 2025 held in Dimapur, Nagaland. Pencak Silat is a traditional form of martial art, originating from Indonesian and Malay Archipelago.

1 Arunachal Pradesh Battalion National Cadet Corps, a part of NCC Group Headquarter Tezpur is conducting Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC - 69) from 16 July to 25 July 2025 for NCC cadets at Rajiv Gandhi University Campus Doimukh. The aim of the camp is to instil the spirit of camaraderie and nationalism among the NCC cadets. 334 volunteer cadets from central and western districts of Arunachal Pradesh are participating in the camp. The training includes physical training, drill, yoga, battle craft, firing and games, debate, essay writing competitions, guest lectures for motivating the cadets by eminent speakers from various fields.

The Tukpen Community Reserve in West Kameng reached a significant conservation milestone with the first-ever sighting of a rare red panda in the Gwanthang area, between Rupa and Thongre village. Sharing the news on social media post today deputy chief minister Chowna Mein said this appearance in the lower ridges far from its typical high-altitude habitat reflects the success of grassroots environmental stewardship and growing awareness among local communities.

Under OPERATION DAWN 2.0, Upper Subansiri Police seized 7.11-gram suspected heroin, 31.07 gm cannabis and proceeds of crime amounting to 7,340 rupees from one individual, was intercepted in a government vehicle. Arunachal Pradesh Police shared it in a social media post today, with accused been arrested, case has been registered and investigation is underway.

Rode Bui, local MLA of Dumporijo, along with local panchayat leaders, circle officer, and DDSE yesterday visited different schools and held meetings with the school authorities to improvise the administration and quality of education system. MLA Bui assured his fullest support to improve the infrastructure of the school. Further, in a coordination meeting with Government Secondary School Paka under Dumporijo Block, 15 lakhs rupees under the MLA-LAD fund were allotted for the maintenance and repair of classrooms to enhance the learning environment for the students.

The Met Centre Itanagar has issued Orange Alerts for East Kameng, Lower Siang, Lepa Rada, East Siang, Lohit, Namsai and Changlang districts, predicting thunderstorm with lightning and heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places. MCI has also issued yellow alert for 15 other districts of the State, forecasting thunderstorm with lightning very likely at isolated places.
