On the occasion, the Minister felicitated the Members for their outstanding parliamentary work. 17 MPs have been awarded Sansad Ratna Awards 2025.

Kargil Vijay Diwas is being celebrated today across the country to honour the bravery of Indian soldiers who sacrificed their lives during the 1999 Kargil War. The day marks the 26th anniversary of India's victory over Pakistan in the conflict and the successful conclusion of Operation Vijay. Today, at Drass, Ladakh, Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu laid wreath at the Kargil War Memorial. In a social media post, he called this day a testament to the spirit of India, and said to remember their victory, courage, sacrifice and unwavering faith in the nation. In the meantime, Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein offered floral tributes to the brave hearts at Namsai.
