Nagaland's para-athlete Hokato Sema secured the gold medal in the Men’s Shot Put F-56/57 category at the 7th Indian Open Para Athletics Championship, which concluded yesterday in Bengaluru. Representing the Services Sports Control Board, the Olympic bronze medalist achieved a winning throw of 14.88 meters on Friday, earning him the top podium spot. The championship drew participation from over 260 para-athletes from across the country and served as the final selection trial for India's national team ahead of the 2025 World Para Athletics Championships, set to be held in New Delhi.
