Prime Minister Narendra Modi will be embarking on a two-nation visit to the United Kingdom and Maldives today. In the first leg, Mr Modi will travel to United Kingdom on a two-day visit. Briefing media in New Delhi yesterday, Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri said, Mr Modi will hold discussions with his British counterpart Keir Starmer and call on King Charles III.

Union Minister of Communications and Development of North Eastern Region (DONER) Jyotiraditya Scindia yesterday highlighted the Northeast's immense potential to spearhead India's sustainable fashion revolution.
